

POLICY RESPECTING BANNERS AND FLAGS

ATTACHED TO AND/OR HANGING FROM TOWN PROPERTY

- A. This policy shall be deemed to include all town property including buildings, utility poles and street lamps.
- B. Any interested group or individual wishing to have a banner or flag placed on town property shall apply in writing to the Town Clerk for permission to do so and shall include in same reason(s) for wanting to have this item(s) displayed on town property. Also, a request date and length of time for placement should be noted.
- C. The town reserves the right to inspect any banner or flag prior to placement on its property.
- D. The only flag(s) that shall be displayed on any Town property shall be the following:
 - 1. A Canadian Flag; or
 - 2. A Provincial Flag; or
 - 3. A Municipal Flag, or
 - 4. Any combination of these flags.
- E. Unless an unusual circumstance prevails, any requests of this kind shall be brought before Town Council for consideration at the next regular meeting of Council following receipt of the application.
- F. In general it shall be the intention of Town Council to only approve requests under the following circumstances:
 - 1. The message being conveyed must be considered to be for the public good;

2. No group or individual shall be promoted to the detriment of another group or individual;
3. The banner or flag must be presentable and should not detract from the appearance of town property.
4. All ropes, attachments, etc. must be provided by the applicant.
