Burning and Dumping Policy

Burning: No burning shall take place within the Town of Antigonish unless permission has been received from the Department of Natural Resources and the Fire Chief to do so and all precautions have been taken to prevent uncontrolled fire. As much as possible any burning will be discouraged and any open burning that does take place must comply with Department of Environment regulations in this regard.

- Dumping:**
- A) No dumping shall take place within the Town of Antigonish unless (a) it is for infilling purposes; (b) it must be environmentally acceptable material appropriate for infilling purposes; and (c) it must be in accordance with the Town's Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use Bylaw. The Development Officer in conjunction with the Town Engineer must give permission for the deposit of any such materials.
 - B) The Town itself may choose to dump inert materials on a temporary basis in an area designated for such purposes on Town owned lands near the Public Works Garage or adjacent to Brierly Brook Road in accordance with Section A above.
 - C) This policy shall not apply to commercial operations involved in the production, collection, processing or sale of construction aggregate material. Motion Carried.
