### Return more than just your Refundables to your Local ENVIRO-Depot™

In addition to the Deposit-Refund Program for Beverage Containers, ENVIRO-Depots™ also accept leftover latex and alkyd household paint. Some ENVIRO-Depots™ also collect lead-acid (automotive) batteries, and waste oil.



Green shading represents curbside collection of organics (green cart) AND garbage. Carts should be placed at curbside no later than 7:30 a.m. on your collection day, and retrieved from the curb promptly following collection.

Locally, the ENVIRO-Depot™ is located at the site of MacMillan's Petro-Canada in South River. Phone 863-1127.

Watch for details on the annual Christmas tree mulching program, tentatively scheduled for the second Saturday in January!

- Blue shading represents curbside collection of recyclables
- Place all bags in plain view of collector. Please ensure bags are not obscured by snow banks which obstruct their view
- Materials should be placed at curbside by 7:30 a.m.

- Garbage is to be placed in standard **CLEAR BAGS**. The use of colored bags is not permitted and your material will be left at curbside for you to retrieve and place in a clear bag.
- One colored solid color bag, no larger than 20 X 22" is permitted for private waste.
- Individual small bags such as kitchen catchers or grocery bags will not be collected.

Reduce! Reuse! Recycle! Rethink!

**Reminder:** The following are **NOT** to be placed in the recyclable bags:

- Tin foil
- Automotive oil containers
- Batteries
- Bio-medical waste (syringes, intravenous bags)
- Building material
- Clothes & shoes
- Cookware & appliances
- Dirty containers (not empty or soiled)
- Household hazardous waste
- Paint
- Pizza boxes
- Styrofoam
- Take-out coffee/tea cups & lids

### TRANSPARENT BLUE BAG #1 PAPER PRODUCTS

- \* Newspapers, flyers & glossy paper
- \* Magazines
- \* Periodicals (i.e. Auto Trader, TV Guide)
- \* Telephone books
- \* Game books (cross word puzzles, pocket novels, etc.)
- \* Hard cover books (remove cover, place in trash)
- \* Egg cartons & 2 ½ dozen flats
- \* Cores from paper towel & toilet tissue rolls
- \* Boxboard (i.e. cereal boxes (liner removed))
- \* Letter, office, school paper and envelopes



### TRANSPARENT BLUE BAG #2 ALL OTHER RECYCLABLES

- \* Milk cartons (cap removed)
- \* Plastic pop bottles (cap removed)
- \* Tin cans (food cans)
- \* Aluminum cans & pie plates
- \* Glass bottles & jars (lids removed)
- \* All liquor containers
- \* Juice boxes (straws removed)
- \* All plastic grocery bags & bread bags
- \* Plastic containers #1-7 (number found on bottom of container)
