

Outdoor Fire By-law Summary

Prohibited:

- You can't use an open fire pit in the Town.
- No outdoor fires on your land or public lands unless you use an approved fire pit.
- Don't burn stuff like regular garbage or yard waste anywhere in the Town.

Permitted:

- You can cook with a portable barbecue or outdoor appliances.
- If you use outdoor gas or wood appliances, follow these rules:
 1. Follow the instructions from the appliance maker.
 2. Only use dry firewood that doesn't make much smoke.
 3. Use something to catch sparks or debris.
 4. Keep the appliance at least 15 feet away from buildings or property lines.
 5. If it's on a wooden deck, put it on a fire-proof pad.
 6. Don't annoy anyone with smoke.
 7. An adult must be there while it's burning.
 8. Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.

Permitted Circumstances:

You can have a fire for training the emergency organizations.

Offences and Penalties:

If you break these rules, you could be fined between \$250 and \$5,000 for each offense (see Schedule A).

Schedule A

Offence	Penalty
First Offence	\$250.00
Second Offence	\$1,000.00
Third Offence	\$5,000.00

The Town can also charge you for any costs or damages because of the offense.
