- Columbus Field

Councillor W. He noted the matter was discussed with planning staff and it appears it would be appropriate to make changes to permit the sea-can during the Municipal Planning Strategy Review.

- Farmers' Market

It was noted a member of the public had called Town Hall to thank Council for their financial support toward the new Farmer's Market.

- Homecoming

Mayor L. Boucher noted she had responded to a member of the public regarding the Town's decision to contribute funds toward St. FX Homecoming. She then read an open letter to the public which will be distributed through various media. Mayor L. Boucher responded to a question from Councillor A. Murray and provided details on the event, noting a similar event was held during Frosh Week and was successful. CAO J. Lawrence noted this event is an option that may not have been available to some students in the past.
