



Invitation of Tender

Town of Antigonish

2024 Active Transportation Corridor – Trunk 4 to James Street

Sealed tenders, clearly marked as 'Town of Antigonish 2023 AT Trail – Project A' and with the bidder's name/address will be received by the Town of Antigonish, at Town Hall, 274 Main Street, Antigonish, NS, B2G 2C4 by 2 p.m. on Thursday, April 11 2024. Tenders are to be dropped off in person.

The work is located on West Street, from Trunk 4 to James Street. The work includes but is not limited to: removal of concrete curb, milling existing street asphalt, street asphalt replacement, the installation of a new watermain, the construction of asphalt multiuse path, the capping of existing infrastructure and the construction of concrete curb and gutter. Work area runs along West Street from Trunk 4 to James Street. Work requires all traffic control, adjustments to catch basins and manhole covers, valve boxes and related work.

Tenders must be accompanied by a bid bond or security bid in the form of a certified cheque for ten percent (10%) of the tender price made in the name of the Town of Antigonish. Surety will be required for good and sufficient performance as noted in the Tender Documents.

Tenderers must provide proof that they have received or are receiving a Certificate of Recognition issued jointly by the Nova Scotia Construction Association and with the Nova Scotia Department of Environment and Labour, as well as providing proof of Workers' Compensation Board clearance, Commercial Liability Insurance, and relevant project experience.

Payment of \$100 (nonrefundable) document fee is to be submitted via mail or paid in person at the Town of Antigonish, 274 Main Street, Antigonish, NS, B2G 2C4 before the date of the tender closing.
